**EXTRACTS FROM CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE WORLD ORGANIZATION OF THE SCOUT MOVEMENT**

**Article X (5)** - *"Any Member Organization which shall have failed to pay its annual registration fee up to and including the end of the fiscal year preceding the Conference shall forfeit its right to vote at that meeting of the Conference, **unless** remission or postponement of dues has received prior authorization from the World Committee".*

The same rule applies to the 9th World Scout Youth Forum.

**EXTRACTS OF CIRCULAR N° 22/1998 OF OCTOBER 1998**

**IMPLICATIONS FOR THE 37th WORLD SCOUT CONFERENCE, TUNISIA, 5-9 SEPTEMBER 2005**

...8. In the document attached to Circular 29/1997 (Section III, 1) *"The World Scout Committee reaffirms that individual participation in the policy and decision making processes at world or regional levels within WOSM through statutory organs, either as a member of or as a delegate to such a body, is restricted to members of WOSM..."* and (Section IV, 8) *"In consequence, the World Scout Committee has decided that, henceforth, there shall be no exceptions to the rules governing the World Organization with regard to individual participation in the WOSM statutory bodies and decision-making processes at world and regional levels."*

9. The rule stated in the above paragraph must be respected by Organizations/Associations when selecting their delegates for the 37th World Scout Conference in Tunisia, the more so since all Organizations/Associations now have the option of having their females become members of WOSM. Consequently, Organizations/Associations whose female members are only members of WAGGGS are welcome to send their female members to the Tunisia Conference, but only as observers, not as delegates with voting rights."

The same rule applies to the 9th World Scout Youth Forum.
