The Strategy for Scouting: WOSM's Support

Dear Colleagues,

At its meeting in April 2004, the World Scout Committee reviewed its progress in providing support to associations in each of the seven strategic priorities. The detailed support to be provided for each strategic priority is set out in the document *A Strategy for Scouting: 'Expected Results & WOSM's Support'*.

In light of the progress to date, the staffing levels and the reduced income to the World Scout Bureau, the World Scout Committee has made three amendments to the support which will be provided before the World Scout Conference in Tunisia in September 2005.

The changes are:

Strategic Priority 5: Volunteers in Scouting

The proposed qualitative survey to measure the effectiveness of the World Adult Resources Policy (WARP) in selected Regions will take place during the next triennium 2005-2008. During the present triennium a guideline on how to produce a qualitative survey which will measure the effectiveness of the WARP and its impact on volunteers will be produced.

Strategic Priority 7: Scouting's Profile (Partnerships)

The evaluation of the recent examples of permanent Global Development Villages will not be undertaken.

Strategic Priority 7: Scouting's Profile (Resources)

The creation of a world-wide network of experts in human resources will be tested by recruiting a small group of volunteers and professionals to undertake some specific tasks.

We look forward to providing a full progress report on the implementation of the Strategy for Scouting at the World Scout Conference in Tunisia.
