2nd Asia-Pacific Poster Competition "Sharing creative concepts and images"

Dear Colleagues,

The Asia-Pacific Region invites all NSOs in the Region to join the second poster competition during the 21st Asia Pacific Regional Conference in Brunei Darussalam.

Objective

To provide a forum for collecting and sharing creative works for the promotion and visibility of Scouting.

Themes

1. Posters promoting Scouting programme
2. Posters promoting membership development
3. Posters promoting a fundraising event

Posters printed before this competition having messages relevant to the themes are welcome as entries.

Message

Each poster must project its message. The wordings can be in any language but a written translation must be attached, if it is not in the English language.

Who can participate

Each NSO can participate in any one or all of the three thematic areas. However, only one entry is allowed for each theme. Designers of the posters may or may not be Scout members as long as the posters are made for use at any Scouting level – group, district, province or national – for the promotion and visibility of Scouting.

Materials

Every entry must be a printout poster (either computer or press printout), not "one-of-a-kind" as in a painting.

Size

Posters must not be smaller than 25 cms x 35 cms and not bigger than 50 cms x 60 cms.

Submission of Entries


NSOs should indicate their interest to join the competition using the attached reply slip. All poster entries must be submitted by NSOs to the conference secretariat upon arrival of their delegation at the conference. All entries will be exhibited at the display area. Extra copies may be brought as give-aways for interested parties at the conference.

Prizes and Awarding

Top three posters of each theme will be awarded prizes. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all NSOs with entries. Prizes will be given during the awarding ceremony of the conference.
