### **20<sup>th</sup> WORLD SCOUT JAMBOREE 2002-2003 – THAILAND IMPORTANT NEWS**

Dear Colleagues,

As announced in Circular of May No. 19/2001, we are pleased to communicate to all National Scout Organizations the following information:

#### **1. JAMBOREE REGISTRATION FEES**

In order to allow more Scouts around the world to attend the 20<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree, as well as more International Service Team members to come and help the Organizers, the Registration Fees have been **significantly reduced** as follows :

Furthermore, the deadline for benefiting from a **10% discount** on the above fees is **postponed until 30 September 2001** (instead of 31 July 2001). The deadline for

5% discount is maintained for 31 December 2001. As mentioned in Bulletin No 1, all fees paid after 30 September 2002 will carry a surcharge of 5%.

In summary, the chart for fee payment is shown in enclosed Appendix.

In order to partially balance the Jamboree budget, ***the duration of the period covered by the registration fees is reduced by one day***. This means that all facilities and services mentioned in the Bulletin No 1 (p. 6) are confirmed except that the maximum of days covered by the fees is now 12 days's meals and no longer 13.

## **2. JAMBOREE DATES**

The official dates of the Jamboree are confirmed as follows:

***From Saturday 28 December 2002 (day of the Opening Ceremony)  
To Tuesday 07 January 2003 (day of the Closing Ceremony).***

The official dates represent a period of 11 days of activities.

The 12<sup>th</sup> day covered by the registration fees can be taken either before (27 December) or after the Jamboree (08 January).

A forthcoming circular will provide more precise information about the dates for the IST members as well as the dates when the Jamboree site will be opened and closed.

## **3. JAMBOREE MANAGEMENT**

A number of modifications concerning the management of the Jamboree during the preparatory phase have been introduced. The main decisions are the following:

The ***Executive Director of the 20<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree*** is Mr. Sutthi Polsaward (who has replaced Dr. Sasithara Pichaichannarong).

The ***Head of the World Scout Jamboree Office*** is Mr. Sommart Sungkapun who was the Executive National Commissioner of Adult Resources and Training of NSOT. Mr. Sungkapun has attended all World Scout Jamborees since Korea in 1991. He is fluent in English.

***Eight operational sectors*** have been defined. These sectors are:

Youth Programme  
Human Resources  
Infrastructure and Maintenance  
Logistics  
Risk Management and Communication  
Administration and General Services  
Public Relations and Protocol  
NSOs and World Scouting

Mrs Wannapa Bromthavorn, Co-ordinator of the Sector of NSOs and World Scouting, is ***responsible for relationships with NSOs and Heads of Contingents***. She is well known in WOSM and experienced in dealing with world matters for she was the NSOT liaison Executive for the 33<sup>rd</sup> World Scout Conference in Bangkok. #### **4. YOUTH PROGRAM OUTLINE & IST CATALOGUE OF POSITIONS**

The *Youth Program Outline* is expected to be included in July Scoutpak. The *IST Catalogue of Positions* together with the final version of the *Application Form* should be mailed to NSOs with the same July 2001 Scoutpak.

#### **5. KEY DATES**

By end of June 2001, after the next preparatory visit of the World Scout Bureau Team, more information will be provided to NSOs about key dates for heads of contingents and IST candidates, including the second visit of heads of contingents to the site and the special regional or inter-regional briefings for Contingents leaders to be held before June 2002.

We hope that the above information will help you in continuing (or even starting) the preparation of your contingent to the 20<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree.
