### **2007 Centenary Information Kit**

Dear Friends,

Scouting's Centenary in 2007 may seem far away, but it is not too soon to be making decisions about the programmes to be implemented in your country. Some programmes will need to be planned, and launched in advance if they are to produce achievements to celebrate in 2007.

Each National Scout Organization will be asked to announce their plans for the world Centenary project, the Gifts for Peace, at the World Scout Conference in Tunisia in 2005. Organizations should also begin planning for their 2007 activities and programme. (Additional information and guidance will be made available at all Regional Conferences in 2004.)

This 2007 kit contains:

1. A new 8-page 2007 Information booklet with an overview of the Centenary objectives and plans.
2. A 2007 flyer, which is available already in six languages.
3. The Legal Protection Document, including instructions for obtaining licences for commercial and non commercial use.
4. A CD containing:
  - a. The 23-page **2007 Centenary Identity Guide** explaining how to use - and not to use - the official Centenary Logo. (A brief explanation is printed on the card to which the CD is attached.) This Guide is indexed for viewing on the computer screen; and it can be printed on paper as needed.
  - b. 2007 Centenary logo artwork in several electronic formats, and 12 languages, plus the means to add other languages.
  - c. High quality versions of publications 1 and 2 for reproduction in your country.
  - d. Artwork for the World Scout Emblem
  - e. The Legal Protection Document

Please use these materials as widely as possible to support discussions and planning for the years leading up to 2007. Use them to help inform potential sponsors or partners.

We also urge all National Scout Organizations to select an individual to represent 2007. This person will be the contact person for the 2007 World Scout Task Force, with responsibility for 2007 promotion, assisting their Organization in their national plans for the Centenary and coordinating the world Centenary project: Gifts for Peace.


