Aim:

The aim of this workshop is to gather at least 2 Senior Leaders from NSOs to help better understand the basics of good governance.

Objectives:

- To share experiences of NSOs on good governance
- To understand why an NSO should undergo a Global Support Assessment Tool (GSAT)
- To equip participants with methods, techniques and tools to be able to benchmark all 10 dimensions of GSAT
- Define post assessment steps towards meeting the standards

This workshop is proposed to gather 40 key leaders (Chief Commissioners, Secretary General, International Commissioners) of the NSO.

Registration Fee:

USD\$150.00 which covers inland transport, food (from lunch on 20 September to lunch on 24 September) and accommodation during the event (check-in on 20th June and check out on 24 September), programme materials.

Airport Reception:

Participants will be met by TGASC Scouts at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE) and will be transported to the venue. For easy recognition, it is expected that participants arrive in uniform or at least wear the scarf. Please ensure to send your itinerary well in advance to TGASC with a copy to us.

Accommodation:

Accommodation will start from 20th night until 23th night (4 nights) in triple or twin sharing rooms.

Visa:

Working Language:

The working language of the workshop is English. Participants must be able to understand and take an active part in the discussions in English.

Weather:

Weather in Taipei in the month of September marks the beginning of Autumn but weather still feels rather hot in the south, with average low and high temperature that ranges from 22°C to 31°C. In the north the weather starts to cool off a bit towards the end of the month.

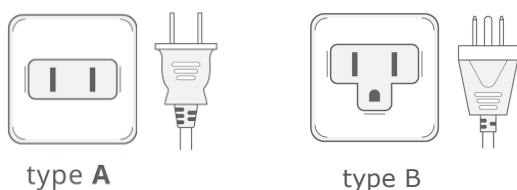
With warm temperatures, light clothing still works best in autumn and a light sweater or coat. It is recommended to always carry a small umbrella.

Currency:

NTD is the official currency, current conversion to USD1.00 is around TWD30.89 (as of 30 April 2019). Credit cards are widely accepted throughout the country. It is highly recommended to change your money at the airport if you do not have credit card.

Electricity:

Taipei has the same electrical standard as the US and Canada: 110V, 60Hz AC. Electrical sockets have two vertical slots.
