**World Scout Seminar on the Scouts of the World Award**

Dear Friends in Scouting,

We are pleased to inform you that the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM) will be organising the World Scout Seminar on the Scouts of the World Award that will be hosted by **Scouts et Guides de France, from 13 - 15 November 2015 in Paris, France**. Previously announced dates were rescheduled due to accommodation constraints and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Key details of the seminar are as follows:

- Aim**
- To gather key Scout leaders of National Scout Organizations (NSOs) and stakeholders from around the world and provide updates on the development of the Scouts of the World (SW) Award programme
  - To revitalise the SW Award programme in the senior Scouts sections (15-26 years age range) to support the continuous growth of Scouting

- Objectives**
- At the end of the seminar, participants will be able
- to explain current changes to the SW Award, the stages of a SW Award Discovery and SW Award Voluntary Service.
  - to understand and explain the SW Award Network, SW Award Bases, SW Award Partnerships and SW Award Support Structures and how the award aligns with the "Better World" framework.
  - to identify strategies to promote the SW Award and how to aid the implementation of the SW Award to the senior Scout sections in their NSO. This will be achieved by the sharing of experiences, success stories and learning from NSOs who have successfully implemented the SW Award.

**Date** 13 - 15 November 2015  
Participants are required to arrive by the evening of **12 November 2015** and may depart on the evening of **15 November 2015 (after 16:00)**.

**Participant Eligibility**            All national and regional **SW Award team members and collaborators** are eligible to attend this seminar.

**Working Language**            As the working language of the seminar is **English**, NSOs are requested to select participants who can communicate and actively take part in English.

**Accommodation**            Participants will stay in shared single sex rooms at the FIAP Jean Monnet. Single rooms may be requested but participants will have to pay the **additional cost**.

**Meals**            Meals provided include **dinner on 12 November until lunch on 15 November**. The cost of additional meals will borne by participants.

**Passport and Visa**            If you need a **visa for France**, please send your passport details to the Scouts et Guides de France, International office and request for a letter of invitation or other documents that you may require for your visa application. Please include SWA Seminar in the subject line of your email. Visa requests should be submitted by 13 September 2015.
