



## 1. COURSE FOR ASSISTANT LEADER TRAINER 2019 (ENGLISH)

**Date:** 17<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019

**Venue:** MASHA International School, Jalan SP2, Bandar Saujana Putra, 426100 Jenjarom  
Selangor.

Participants are expected to arrive on 16<sup>th</sup> August and may leave after 3 pm of 23<sup>rd</sup> August May, or on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

Training Team Members and Course Staff are expected to arrive on the afternoon of 16<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and depart on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

**Participants:** Qualified, eligible Wood Badge holders endorsed / recommended by NSOs.

**VISA:** As with other countries, an International Passport or valid travel documents recognized by the Malaysian Government and internationally, is required for any foreign nationals entering Malaysia. The passport must have enough pages for the embarkation stamp upon arrival and be valid for at least 6 months at the date of entry.

A visa is not necessary for travellers coming from certain countries. For those who require visa, three types of visas can be obtained, whichever is applicable: single entry, multiple entry or transit visa. Visas have to be applied for in advance but the final decision for allowance of entry is at the discretion of the Immigration Officer at the entry point.

No visa is required for a stay of less than one month for nationals of all ASEAN countries except Myanmar. For a stay exceeding one month a visa will be required, except for nationals Brunei and Singapore.

### **Course for Assistant Leader Trainer Participants Fees:**

**Time Zone:** Malaysia is eight hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+8)

**Currency:** Malaysian currency is called “Malaysian Ringgit” (MYR). USD 1.00 is equal to about MYR 4.14. Most transaction of sale will be in Malaysian Ringgit (MYR). Therefore it is advice for all overseas participants and overseas staff to have your currency exchanged at the foreign exchange counter (banks like CIMB, Maybank) in Kuala Lumpur International Airport or have them exchanged from their respective country.

**Electricity:**



You **can use** all your equipment in **Malaysia** if the standard voltage in your own country is between **220V-240V**.



In **Malaysia** the power **plugs** and sockets are of **type G**. The standard voltage is 240 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.
