12-14 October 2003

Dear Colleagues:

It is our pleasure to announce that the next APR Scout Summit will be hosted by Gerakan Pramuka at their National Scout Camp in Jakarta, Indonesia.

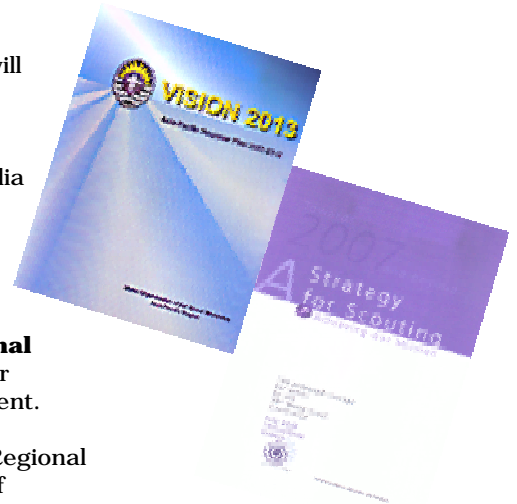
The last three summits held in the Philippines, Japan, and Australia had proven that this is an important event concerning the operations of Scouting in the Region.

On behalf of the region and the host association, we extend invitation to three key leaders of National Scout Associations: **Top Volunteer** (Chief Commissioner or equivalent), **International Commissioner**, and **Top Professional** (Chief Scout Executive or equivalent). We strongly urge your presence in this important event.

Further, I would like to inform you that Members of Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Committee, Strategic Planning Committee and Chairmen of Sub-Committees will be directly involved in running the Summit.

The event details are as follows:

- Event Title:** 4<sup>th</sup> APR Scout Summit
- Dates:** 12 to 14 October 2003 (participants are expected to arrive on 11 October and plan to depart on 15 October 2003)
- Venue:** Gerakan Pramuka Scout Camp Cibubur, Jakarta (this is about 20km from International airport, about 45minutes drive)
- Accommodation:** Room sharing, mostly air conditioned.
- Other facilities:** Swimming pool, sports hall, tennis court, jogging trek, recreational park and soccer field.



**Fee:** US\$200.00 (this will cover inland transportation, food and accommodation during the summit, documents and souvenirs)

**Objectives:**

- Analyze the growth of Scouting in the Asia Pacific Region
- Align APR Plan 2013 with WOSM Strategy 2007
- Review Regional Priority areas and objectives including Action Steps under each priority plan for the next phase 2004-2007
- Review WOSM policies, Conference resolutions and thematic areas (environment, co-education, peace etc.)

**Weather:** October is a bit warm, about 33° C and occasionally with rains.

**Programme:** The host association will arrange a spouse programme. Visit to Taman Mini Indonesia, Museum, Art Gallery, Sea World, New China Village and shopping is under consideration for the inclusion in the programme. The confirmed programme will be intimated to registered participants.

**Tours:** Those who may be willing to tour in Indonesia before or after the summit, host association suggests two packages:


- Yogyakarta and Borobudur ( 3days 2 nights)
