6th International Adventure Programme

We are pleased to inform you that the Bharat Scouts and Guides, India is organizing the 6th International Adventure Programme at their National Adventure Institute. This Institute is situated at the National Training Centre of Bharat Scouts & Guides at Pachmarhi, M.P. India, a place known as "Trekking Paradise" and touches the heart of adventurers with one feel closer to the Creator and to India's past.

The NAI was established in the year 1992 and since then, adventure activities and programmes are being successfully conducted under the guidance of five (5) trained staff members. The NAI uses adventure-based activities for character development, team building and self-discovery sessions.

Below are the basic information of the Programme

Date : 16th Feb. to 25th Feb. 2004

Venue : The National Adventure Institute of the Bharat Scouts & Guides, Pachmarhi, M.P., 461 881, India

How to Reach : There is a direct flight from Delhi/Mumbai to Bhopal. Transportation will be arranged from airport in Bhopal to Pachmarhi. There are also direct trains from Howrah, Mumbai and Chennai to Pipariya, which is the nearest railway station to Pachmarhi. If you are coming from Delhi to Bhopal, trains are frequently available. Inland transportation will be arranged from Bhopal/Pipariya Railway Station to Pachmarhi.

Programme fee : U.S. \$ 60.00 per head which covers inland transportation between Bhopal/Pipariya and Pachmarhi, hospitality, food, accommodation, insurance, activity cost, development fee and registration fee.

Eligibility : Senior Scouts/Girl Scouts, Rovers/Rangers and adult Leaders between 15 and 45 years old, having good health and can bear the strain of adventure, may apply. The programme is expected to have 50 overseas participants and 100 local participants from India.

Programme Highlights : Trekking, Rock climbing, Mountaineering, obstacles crossing, Night Scouting, Nature Ramble, Star Gazing, Horse riding, skating, swimming, boating, Back-Woods-man-cooking, Parasailing, Jungle camping.

What to bring : Mat, Sleeping Bag, Haversack/Rucksack, Uniform, Torch, Water Bottle, toilet requisites, clothing to change, Camera etc.
