WoodBadge100 Celebrations in the Asia-Pacific Region

Dear colleagues,

Greetings from Asia-Pacific Support Centre!

In celebration of the 100 years of shaping leaders (Woodbadge100), we are pleased to inform you that the Asia-Pacific Region of the World Organization of the Scout Movement in collaboration with the Scout Association of Hong Kong (SAHK) is organizing the WoodBadge100 Celebrations from 21-24 April 2019 in Hong Kong.

The WoodBadge100 aims to commemorate the one hundred years since the first Wood Badge course was conducted. There will be two parts of the Woodbadge Celebrations in the Asia-Pacific Region, they are:



APR Adults in Scouting Workshop

A three-day workshop on Adults in Scouting is organized to gather Leaders of Adults in Scouting. The objectives of the workshop is, as follows:

- To revisit the World Scout Adults in Scouting Policy and emphasize that Wood badge is a component of the training path within Adults in Scouting life cycle;
- To list best practices on Recruitment and Retention; and
- To share best practices on Adult Training Systems that help increase the number of effective adult leaders and motivate adult leader to be involved and committed to Scouting.

The workshop will be held from 21-24 April 2019 at the B.P. International House in Hong Kong. Participants are requested to arrive in Hong Kong on 20 April 2019 and may leave in the evening of 24 April 2019, onwards.

Fee:

The registration fee for the workshop is USD150.00 per participant to cover local transportation, meals, accommodation for the workshop duration, documents, souvenirs, half-day educational tour, etc.

Eligibility:

Key leaders, preferably Wood Badge holders, who are in-charge of training and development of adults in Scouting; Commissioners, National Training Team members, and full-time executives who are responsible for AIS or Adult Training and Development.

Working Language:

The working language of the workshop is English. National Scout Organizations are requested to select participants who are able to communicate and take an active part in discussions in English.

Woodbadge Reunion

Coinciding with the workshop, a one-day program of activities to celebrate 100 years of unique educational initiative, the Woodbadge, developed by the Baden Powell. This gathering will showcase examples of Wood Badge "rituals" and traditions worldwide. National Scout Organizations who will attend this reunion will be asked to join the Wood Badge Heritage Exhibition, where NSOs can bring with them and feature items like pictures, scarves, certificates, etc.

This event will be held from the afternoon of 22 April 2019 at the Tai Tam Scout Centre in Hong Kong and will end with a campfire on the same day. This half-day event will be limited to only 100 overseas Scout Leaders.

The registration fee is USD20.00 which will cover food and inland transportation. Please note that the registration fee for this half-day event does not include accommodation.

In sending the nomination, please fill up the attached Reply Slip and send it to Scout Association of Hong Kong , and copy to the World Scout Bureau Asia-Pacific Support Centre not later than **15 March 2019**.


