### **Update on World Scout Event Bids**

Dear friends,

Following an extensive and robust due diligence process, and subsequent review by the World Scout Committee at its recent meeting in late September, I am excited to provide an update on the bids from National Scout Organizations (NSOs) to host the upcoming 43<sup>rd</sup> World Scout Conference, 17<sup>th</sup> World Scout Moot, and 26<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree events.

**World Scout Conference 2023:** circular no. [22/2018](#) called for NSOs to express interest in hosting the 43<sup>rd</sup> World Scout Conference in 2023 and I am pleased to share that the NSOs of France and Mexico have been accepted to present a bid during the 42<sup>nd</sup> World Scout Conference in 2020.

**World Scout Moot 2025:** circular no. [23/2018](#) called for NSOs to express interest in hosting the 17<sup>th</sup> World Scout Moot in 2025 and I am pleased to share that the NSOs of Azerbaijan and Portugal have been accepted to present a bid to the 42<sup>nd</sup> World Scout Conference in 2020.

**World Scout Jamboree 2027:** circular no. [24/2018](#) called for NSOs to express interest in hosting the 26<sup>th</sup> World Scout Jamboree in 2027 and I am pleased to share that the NSO of Poland has been accepted to present a bid to the World Scout Conference in 2020.

All bidders for World Scout Events have committed to uphold the [WOSM Code of Conduct for Bidders for World Scout Events](#) and the World Scout Bureau will continue to monitor all bidders for World Scout Events against these standards.

I look forward hearing more about the bid proposal details from our Scouting friends in France, Mexico, Azerbaijan, Portugal and Poland as they prepare to deliver a full presentation during the 42<sup>nd</sup> World Scout Conference in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt next year.
